



Senior Summer Camp Counselor

The Tatnall School is seeking energetic and responsible Senior Summer Camp Counselors to join our summer team. Counselors play an integral role in creating memorable experiences and serve as leaders and role models to our campers.

The Senior Counselor will be responsible for an assigned group of campers and will work closely with one junior counselor and supervise one or two Counselors in Training (CIT.) Senior Counselors will be responsible for overseeing transitions to and from scheduled events, facilitating activities, and creating a fun and safe experience for all campers. The ideal candidate will be an excellent multi-tasker with a genuine passion for working with and empowering young people. Applicants should be patient, fun-loving, and confident in their ability to lead campers through their exciting camp journey.

Essential Functions

- Leading a group of assigned campers; ensuring that campers are safe and accounted for at all times
- Leading lessons and activities including arts and crafts, sports and games, STEM activities, etc.
- Coordinating and implementing assigned group's daily schedule; ensuring the group is on time and prepared for all activities
- Playing a lead role in mediating any camper conflicts
- Coordinate with Junior Camp Counselors; assign tasks; provide feedback and suggestions
- Providing feedback to Camp Coordinators about campers, activities, and Junior Camp Counselors

Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- College degree or significant college coursework preferred
- Minimum of 3 years of previous experience working with children ages 3-14 in a summer camp or school setting
- Preference is given to candidates available to work the full summer (June 20 through August 19)
 - The approximate schedule will be 8:00am to 3:15 Monday through Friday, with additional hours in Extended Day available for some counselors
 - Participation in Camp Orientation, scheduled for June 10, is mandatory
- Current CPR / AED Certification; Certification with First Aid Training is a plus
- Demonstrates ability to supervise children while still encouraging and creating a fun environment
- Knowledge of various camp activities and games is a plus
- Must have current TB test (within 1 year) and be able to pass a background check
